Time's running out to catch these must-see art exhibits

As November winds to a close, so are a couple of art exhibits worth giving thanks for, and worth adding to your must-see list this week. The quick-and-dirty on these must-see shows:

- What: *Howard Sherman: When gorillas shoot pigs*

- Why: It's been a pleasure watching the cartoonist-turned-painter's development since earning a master's degree from the University of North Texas in 2006. His third solo McMurtrey exhibition shows him continuing to mix splashy gestures with hard-edged painting, *trompe l'oeil* • details and dashes of graffiti but with an increasingly sophisticated color palette as his confidence and the elegance of his compositions grow.
- What: *Katja Loher: Sculpting in Time*

- Why: The New York-based Swiss artist's Houston debut is a doozy. Embedding labor-intensive, highly choreographed videos into spherical sculptures — or in some cases, projecting them onto weather balloons, she turns the gallery into a mini-solar system well worth visiting. A peephole-themed piece turns the tables on the voyeuristic viewer, but I won't say how. Go see for yourself.
